Are you ready to make a difference in the lives of children and young people?

As part of its 15th anniversary, LR Global Kids Fund (LRGKF) is looking for local heroes who are passionate about making a positive impact on young people.

Submit your project idea by 18 October 2024 and you could win €1,000 to make your vision a reality!

Your project needs to focus on one of these:

- » Education: Literacy programmes, tutoring, after-school activities
- » Language & Literacy: Reading clubs, storytelling events, language classes
- » Sports & Health: Fitness programmes, sports teams, health education
- » Music & Arts: Music lessons, art classes, cultural events
- » Inclusion & Integration: Refugee support, multicultural events
- » Talent Development: Talent support, events.
- » Career Development: Job training, mentorship programs

Imagine the possibilities: A reading buddy taking children on literary adventures, a swimming coach offering lessons to underprivileged youngsters, or a choir director taking his young singers on a concert tour. Your €1,000 can be used to kick-start your project or contribute to a larger initiative.

How does it work?

1. **Submit your idea:** As a current LRGKF member, simply submit your project proposal.
2. **Selection process:** The LRGKF Board will select 15 high impact projects.
3. **Award ceremony:** You'll have the opportunity to personally present the €1,000 grant on behalf of the LRGKF.

The application period runs from 15 September to 18 October 2024. The winners will be announced in December 2024.

Is your project eligible?

- » You must be an active sponsor of the LRGKF.
- » Your project must benefit children and young people aged 18 and under.
- » Your project must address at least one of the priority areas listed.
- » Your project should have a defined timeline and be completed by the end of 2025.
- » The organisation receiving the grant must be a tax-recognized charity.
- » The charity must agree to provide project updates and photographs (minimum 300 dpi).
- » All application forms must be completed in full.
